THE Garrison Players' final production of the current season, Ibsen's "Peer Gynt", is scheduled to open in Loke Yew Hall on April 21, with additional performances on April 22 and 23. Without a doubt, it is just about the most ambitious undertaking ever attempted by the Garrison Players.

Barbara Lawrence, veteran producer of many of Hong Kong's successful plays, has gathered together for this production most of the Colony's top talent to fill the more than 35 roles portrayed in Ibsen's poetic fantasy woven out of the folk lore of his native country, Norway.

David Jordan, 35-year old civil servant and a leading Colony actor, was selected to fill the role of Peer Gynt in casting sessions held last month. Producer Lawrence chose Rosemary Brooks, who has appeared behind the footlights of Hong Kong staged productions for the past seven years, to portray Solveig, Peer's girl-friend.

Others, well-known to Hong Kong's theatre goers, who will appear in the play are Anne Choy, Mary Smith, Margaret Howlett, P. G. Hiller, Otto Jager, Roger Needell and June Elliott. The play also provides ample opportunity for the participation of the pre-teenage group and more than a few of Hong Kong's youngsters who aspire for a stage career are taking part.

The Norwegian Consul General is giving full co-operation and assistance to the group. Approximately half of the proceeds derived from the sale of tickets for the three performances are being donated to the aid of the Colony's refugees through the local committee of World Refugee Year.

A spokesman for the Garrison Players has announced that buses are to be provided for Kowloon residents on all three nights. They will leave Queen's Pier for Loke Yew Hall 20 minutes before curtain time.

Tickets for all three performances are on sale at Skinnars.

Plan Staging Ibsen's 'Peer Gynt'

Monday, Feb. 22

The Garrison Players have announced plans to stage Henrik Ibsen's "Peer Gynt." The play is scheduled for April 20, 21 and 22, at Loke Yew Hall, University of Hongkong.

Barbara Lawrence, who has staged several of the Garrison Players' most successful plays, will produce Ibsen's poetic fantasy woven out of the folklore of his native country, Norway. The sets will be designed by Bob Elliott and Bob Davis.

Mrs. Lawrence, in accepting the producer's role, announced her plans to initiate a search for new talent in the Colony. Casting meetings will be held in the Mission to Seamen's auditorium on Feb. 24 and 25, at 8 p.m.

In addition to our members of the Garrison Players we will need many dancers and children of all nationalities," she said.

"The Norwegian Consul General has promised full co-operation and assistance to make this, our final production of the season, an outstanding success and we would like the help of all who would like to assist in the backstage work. They, too, should attend the casting meetings if they want to volunteer for this very interesting work," she added.

Selection for more than 35 roles in the play will be made following the final casting session on Feb. 25.

When I came to the Colony in 1951, so firm liaison existed between the Players and the Stage Club. Since then, that has changed. Today, relations between the two drama groups are most cordial, yet friendly rivalry continues in relation to each group's productions.

There are limited resources in regard to performers and producers within the non-professional Stage in Hongkong. And because of this, both the Players and the Stage Club get along smoothly by assisting one another wherever possible.

There is scope for the continuance of both drama groups in this Colony: the past season has confirmed that each is performing a sterling service to the theatre-minded community. May it long continue thus.

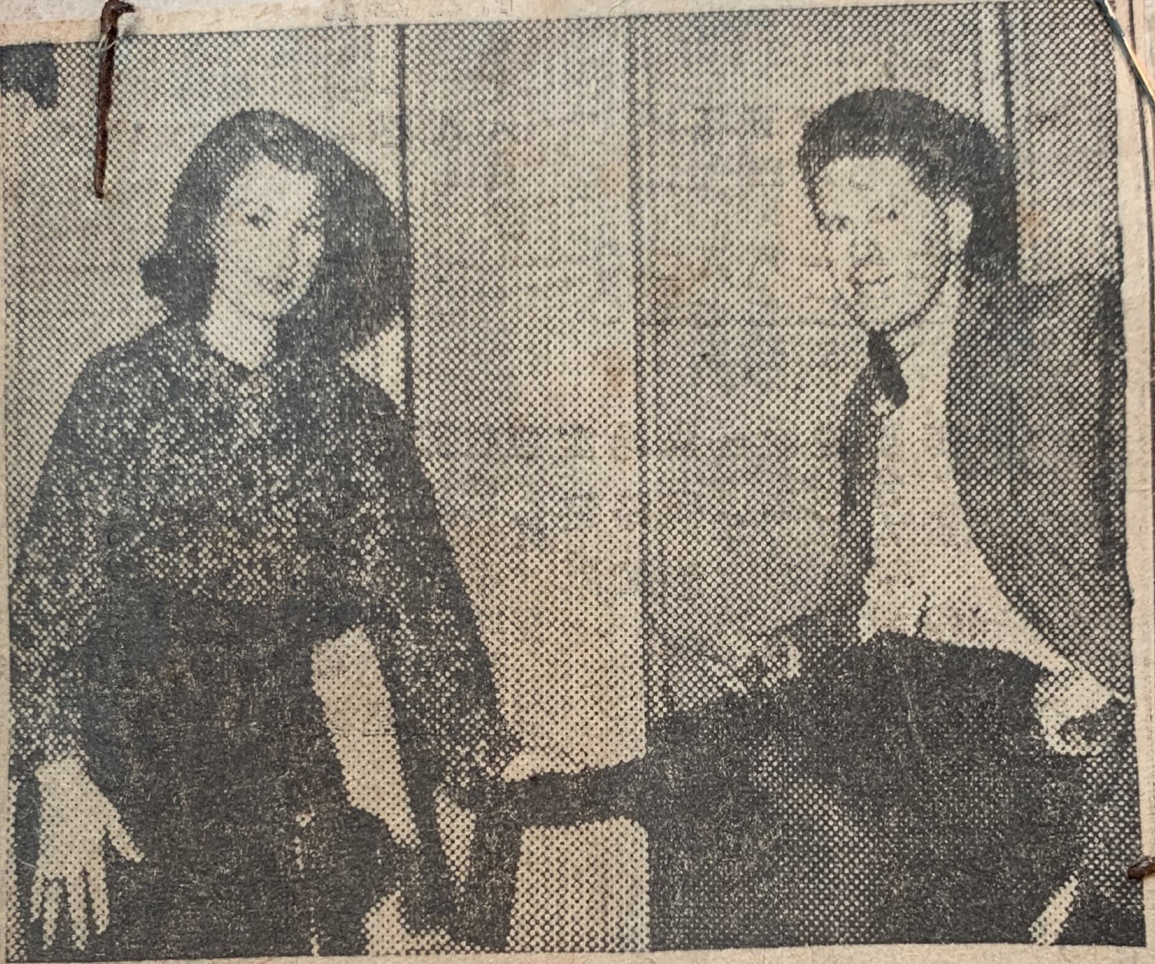

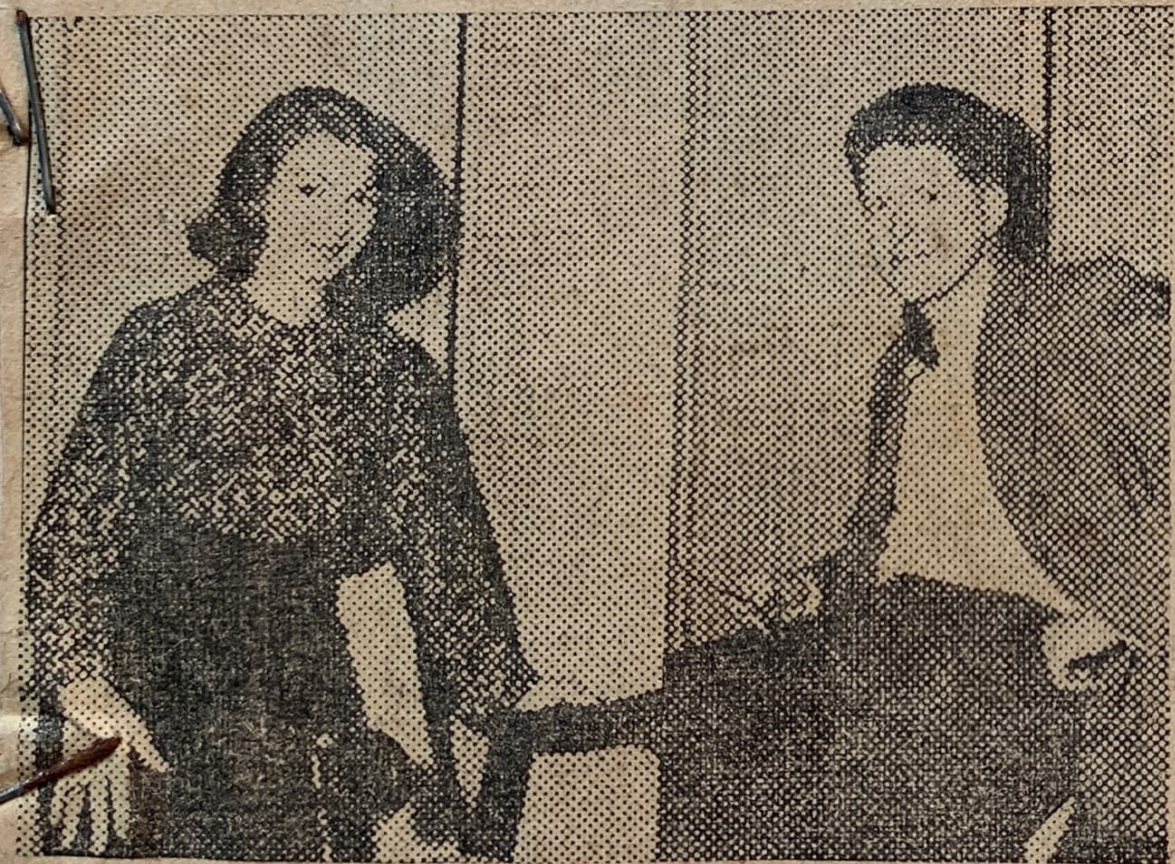

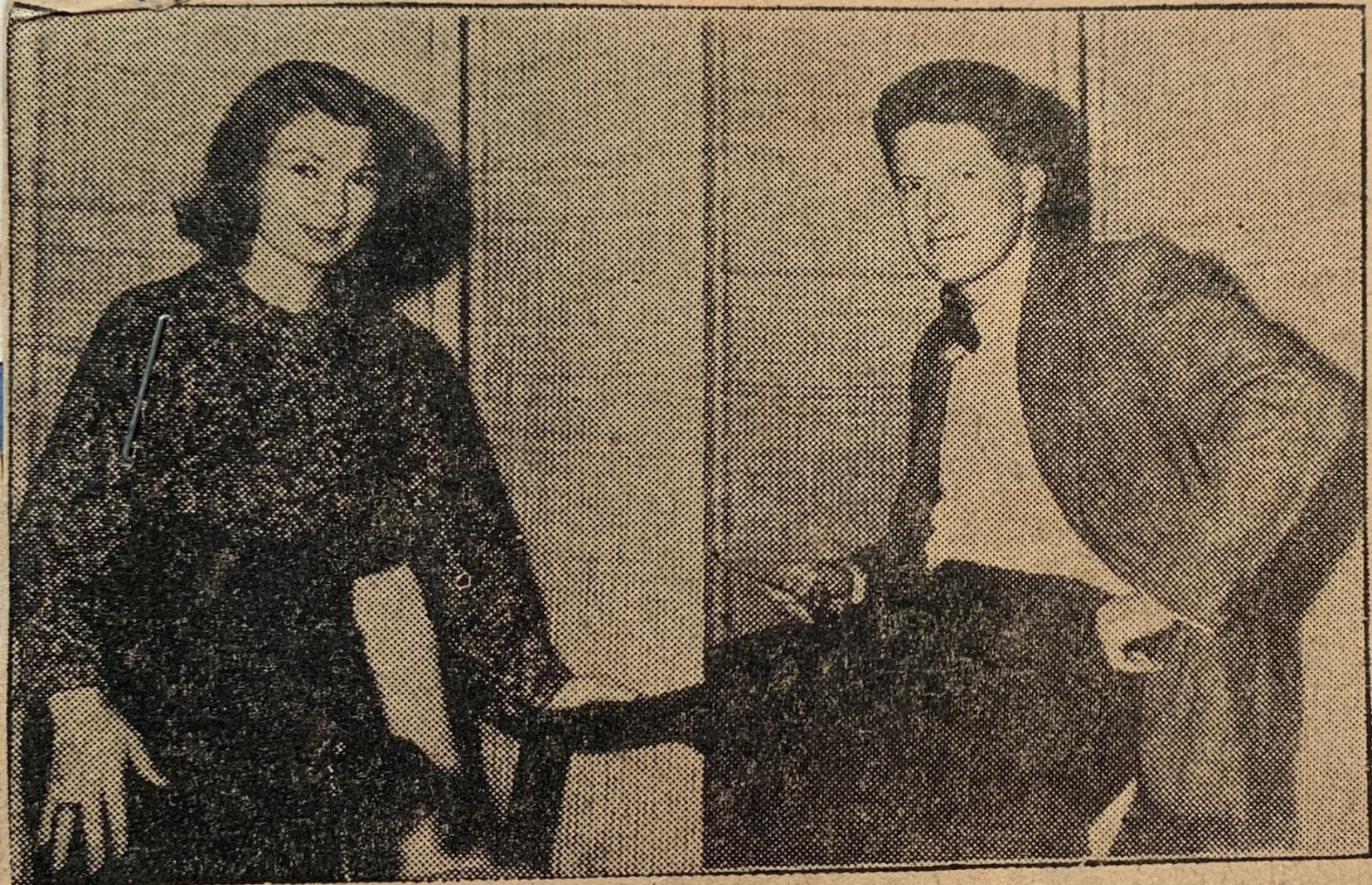

The Hongkong Council of Social Service yesterday gave a tea for women who will lead a concentrated, week-long drive to raise funds for World Refugee Year.

The Council will hold the drive in the week beginning on May 8. One of the goals of the drive will be to raise money for the Council's community centre fund.

Attending yesterday's tea party at the Gloucester Hotel were Mrs H. D. M. Barton, Miss Aw Sian, Mrs Kwok Chan and many others who will take a lead in this project.

Many functions have been arranged for raising funds during the week in May, including a concert to be given by the Boys' and Girls' Clubs Association, a photographic exhibition by members of the Young Women's Christian Association, and a play, "Peer Gynt,"—by the Garrison Players.

A film premiere will also be held, though the film to be shown, "Solomon and Sheba," will not be available until early June.

Since World Refugee Year ends in June, Miss C. M. Newcombe, secretary of the Council, is anxious to exploit every idea and the good offices and energy of all those who are willing to help during the special refugee fund week.
